



2015 Neighborhood Project Fund

- Program:** The DaVinci Investors have established a small grant program to support activities that improve the quality of life within the DaVinci community redevelopment area. **We are especially interested in projects which promote neighborhood pride and build relationships between residents, civic groups, businesses and neighborhood institutions.**
- Grant:** The Neighborhood Project Fund will support activities that encourage positive neighborhood interaction through resident-organized events. We seek projects that result in residents contributing to their neighborhoods in meaningful ways. We are also interested in projects with a deliberate strategy to include new and previously uninvolved residents of the community.
- Who May Apply:** Applicants must: (1) live or work in the DaVinci redevelopment area -AND- (2) represent a block club, civic group, neighborhood association, or other community-oriented group or institution in the neighborhood. Outside groups must partner with a local organization to be considered. - Deadline:** Applications **MUST be turned in at least four weeks before the money will be needed.** No exceptions will be made. Applications may be sent by email or regular mail.

- Selection:** Applicants will be **notified by email within two weeks of submission** whether their request has been approved.
- Award:** **Funds are limited. The Neighborhood Project Fund is designed to support small grant requests of under \$500.** Applicants are strongly encouraged to contribute to the projects they propose. Contributions may include a cash commitment and/or services, equipment, supplies and volunteer hours. Receipts for funds spent will be required. **Volunteer hours can be used as match. One hour of volunteer time equals \$10.00.**
- Award Process:** Funds can be distributed in three ways: (1) We can pay a vendor directly, upon submission of an invoice (for example, to a food vendor you may use); (2) We can write a check to your organization for the full amount. You must then submit all receipts related to the activity documenting costs; (3) We can reimburse you after an event with submission of receipts.
- Evaluation:** Photos and event materials are welcome. DaVinci project staff may attend your event. **You may be asked to complete a brief evaluation form.**
